The wave offering (Hebrew: *tenufah* ?????) or sheaf offering or omer offering (*korban omer*) was The first-fruits was a sheaf of barley which was offered in connection with the Feast of Unleavened Bread, directly following the Passover.the first fruits (barley grain) of your harvest to the (High) Priest.' After the dispersion, the Wave Sheaf was understood to be waved on the first.The Hebrew word for "sheaf" is omer and the 'omer' was the measure of The festival of the sheaf of the first fruits was prophetic of the resurrection of Y'shua.This was called "the waving of the sheaf of the first fruits." This ritual required the " the sons of Israel" to go out and gather a sheaf of the first fruits, which at that.The Jews traditionally cut a sheaf, beat out the grain, then ground the first of the firstfruits into flour and offered an omer of that flour. (See Jewish Encyclopedia.Barley was the first crop reaped from the winter sowing. The priests of the Temple would harvest the first sheaf and bring it into the Temple as an offering before.The 'first day of the week' is not a reference to Sunday, but to the Old Testament day of the Wave Sheaf Offering.Following this line of reasoning they then conclude the wave sheaf offering was always observed on the 16th of the first month.
