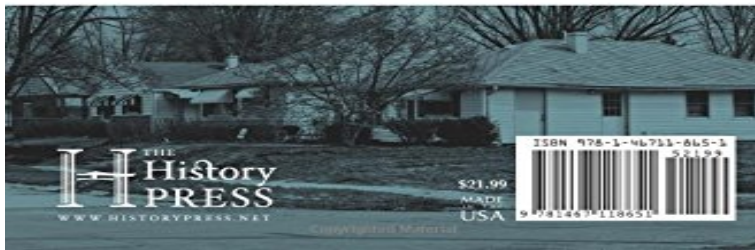


German Settlers of South Bend (Voices of America)
